

We hope that your RV Rally will be filled with fun activities, informative seminars, and interesting tours of the local community. Included in this booklet there are many things that will help you to get the most from your RV Rally experience. Some of them you have already learned since you drove to the gate and met the Wagon master and the Parking Crew. They are here to see that you are safely parked. Once parked you cannot move without one of the "Crew" to help you. This is for your safety as well as those around

you. If you arrived after dark or during the program you were placed in a "holding area" and provided with electric. You will be moved to your permanent location the following morning. Please arrive with water tank and propane tanks full and your waste tanks empty. Dump stations will be available upon your departure. You will be parked in an area where electricity is available. Please bring an extra electric cord (12 gauge or larger) with you. You will be parked as close to an electrical source as possible, but the supply is limited. Do not use any appliances that draw a large amount of electric such as heaters, air conditioners, or microwaves. Set your refrigerator and water heaters on propane, this will help to prevent a blackout of a large number of rigs.

Handicapped parking is available for those with blue handicap tag and/or doctor's letter for special needs. We will do our best to accommodate, but cannot guarantee that we meet all needs. You will

not park with your chapter if you require handicapped parking. Your tow vehicle must be removed from your rig. This insures that fire lanes are not blocked

The Ohio Good Sam has a staff of volunteers that are chosen by the Ohio State Director that work very hard to put this RV Rally on for you. They wear golf shirts of Orange color each day, and have the word

"STAFF" on the back. During the evening program they are dressed in white with black shirts. We welcome any questions and comments you wish to make. Please introduce yourself to them and let them know if you are having a good time.

Host chapters also volunteer to help put on the RV Rally. They can be seen doing many jobs such as parking, electrical, hospitality, registrations, security, miscellaneous, door prizes, games, popcorn and many other things to make the rally a success. We appreciate all their time and hard work.

At the gate you will receive your Program, this has the time everything will be happening. Also it has the time Registration is open. At registration you will receive a goody bag, a door prize number, patches and Meal ticket if you purchased one. Also you may sign up for tours.

If you are a FIRST TIMER please stop at the FIRST TIMER table to receive a name tag with a red ribbon to identify you as a first timer. Remember to wear it each day. The registration area is also the location to sign up for games, craft classes and other miscellaneous information.

A program, map of the fairgrounds with the chapters parking list are posted at the entrance of each building.

In the Merchants area there are commercial vendors with many products and services for sale. Stop and see what they have to offer. This is also where you find the Good Sam Store. The vendors hours are from 9:00-4:00 pm. You may purchase patches, and other Good Sam merchandise. Make sure to stop in and say "HI" to Betty.

Bring your door prize ticket you received at registration to all programs. It is a good idea to write your name on it in case you lose it. Door prizes are drawn often from the stage and you must have your ticket with you to win.

There is no smoking in or near the buildings entrances or exits. Pets are not allowed in the buildings and must be on a leash at all times. You must ALWAYS clean up after them.

At entertainment, we ask that all men remove their hats. Bring your own chairs. No rockers or recliners PLEASE. High back chairs must sit only on one side of the stage. The attendants helping with chairs will help you determine which side is correct.

Emergencies sometimes occur during a RV Rally. Please let a Staff member help you. If you experience an emergency during the night, please turn on your vehicles headlights and blow the horn three times.

We have a security golf cart that patrols the grounds during the night, they will come to you. **DO NOT LEAVE YOUR RIG.** If they are not there immediately, repeat the procedure. Remember the emergency phone numbers are listed on your program. When dialing 911 from a cell phone you may not be calling the LOCAL 911 service, so make sure you state your location, which is on the program, use the fairground name and county. On security member will stay with you and the other will go to the fairground gate and lead the EMS to your location.

It is our sincere desire that you have an enjoyable experience here at the Ohio RV Rally. We look forward to seeing you back again and hope you bring a friend with you.
